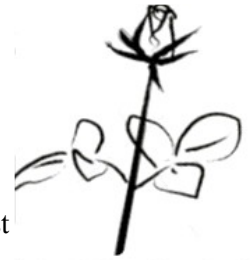

## NOTICE OF SPECIAL VESTRY

Notice is given that a Special Vestry meeting will be held on Sunday, May 15, 2011 at 11:30 a.m. in the Church auditorium following the 10 a.m. service. The purpose of this special Vestry shall be for the election of members to a Parish Selection Committee ("PSC"). The PSC will be tasked to select a new Incumbent.

Full reference to the process for selection of a new Incumbent is set out in Canon 6 which may be located at [www.toronto.anglican.ca/images/up-4canon10.pdf](http://www.toronto.anglican.ca/images/up-4canon10.pdf)

Canon 6 provides that the Parish Selection Committee ("PSC") shall consist of the Churchwardens and such other members of the parish; not fewer than 4, or more than 6, to a maximum of 8, to be determined by the Churchwardens, and to be elected by Vestry.

The composition of the PSC should attempt to reflect the diverse communities within the parish. The members of the PSC shall elect a chair from among their number. According to the foregoing the Wardens are to put forward a slate of candidates for election. We believe the number of candidates should consist of 6 elected individuals who, with the 2 Wardens, will form a PSC of 8
